Pakistan is an Islamic country with a population of over 167 million of which 1% are Christian. ACBM preaching by correspondence began in 2002. Despite frequent reports of political unrest, killings and bombings, the Truth has taken root and there is now over 300 brothers and sisters in 13 ecclesias in the country. Bro. Tim Galbraith has made six visits to this troubled country and has been very enthusiastic about the interest and dedication of those he met.

Three Bible Weeks have been held in recent years and all attending were greatly encouraged in their faith by the talks given by overseas and local speakers. The first Pakistan Christadelphian Youth Conference was held in November 2009 attended by 60 brothers and sisters and young people. Bro. Tim and seven Pakistani brethren gave encouraging studies all related to young believers, their character building and spiritual guidance. Preaching work continues by e-mail and another Bible Week is planned for June 2010.



VANUATU

The truth in Vanuatu Islands has reached at least the main islands of Vanuatu; Efate, Malekula, Santo and Tanna. There are a total of 82 islands, and some brethren and sisters are in isolation where they are only reachable by boat or plane.

In 2009 there were three baptisms one in Santo, Malekula and Tanna. There are about 30 active contacts in Vanuatu, with Sunday schools and studies.

There has been positive feedback in Vanuatu, and this year an ecclesial hut is being built in Malekula. The hut is yet to be completed, but earlier this year Fieldworkers helped local brethren for a week, putting up rafters and roofing. There is of great interest of the truth in Malekula and there is one active contact there who will be baptised this year, God willing.



There was an annual Camp organised in Port Vila, Vanuatu's capital looking at Abraham and the promises. This was a refreshing and spiritual uplifting experience for all brethren and sisters and enabled all to learn that regardless of background, race and culture "we are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all have been baptised into Christ. If we belong to Christ, then we are Abraham's seed and heirs according to the promise" (Galatians 3:26,29).

Vanuatu Motto's is "In God we Stand" and about 98% of people here in Vanuatu believe in God but yet lack the knowledge of the truth. "HOW SHALL THEY HEAR WITHOUT A PREACHER. THE DAY IS SO SHORT ... THE WORK IS SO GREAT..."
